OBJECTIVE

We are committed to being a self-sustainable corporation in our production processes, which leads us to comply with the conservation and protection of the environment, in addition to always ensure the welfare of our employees, as well as guide plans, programs and projects related to maintaining environmental quality and sustainability of biodiversity and natural resources.

This commitment is achieved through a dynamic of gradual change and building consensus with the communities neighboring the production areas, with social participation and inclusion in the environmental management processes to make use of natural resources in a sustainable development approach.

SCOPE

This policy is applicable to all employees who are part of the corporation, independent producers and other stakeholders.

DEFINITION

In order to comply with this policy with the social requirements and with our customers' demands in terms of quality standards, we implement the following statements:

- The conservation and improvement of the natural ecosystems that exist in the farms where productive processes are conducted, with the purpose of preserving and recovering the biodiversity of wildlife, flora and fauna, as well as the conservation of soil, air and water resources;
- Make adequate and rational use of phytosanitary products, with the purpose of reducing the environmental impact they produce;
- Use only phytosanitary products approved and regulated by the destination markets in accordance with the legislation that regulates this matter;
- All employees who may be exposed to the use of phytosanitary products will receive training and the necessary equipment to avoid health risks;
- Ensure the health of employees and occupational safety. For this purpose, training will be provided on these topics.

GUIDING PRINCIPLES



Within the development of the environmental management process, we contemplate the following principles:

- I. Sustainable development;
- II. The general good prevails over the individual good;
- III. Civic engagement and social co-responsibility;
- IV. Biodiversity protection (no fishing, no logging and no hunting);
- V. Any type of burning is prohibited.

The implementation of this policy is in accordance with environmental management regulations, and is therefore regulated in two areas of environmental compliance and subdivided into environmental thematic areas as follows:

- 2 Sustainable Management of Natural Heritage Area
 - 2.1 Non-Renewable Natural Resources Area
 - 2.2 Renewable Natural Resources Area
 - 2.3 Biodiversity Preservation Area
 - 2.4 Basins and Water Area
